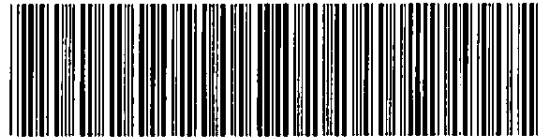





SECTION 1 INTRODUCTION AND PRELIMINARY STATEMENTS

SECTION 12 INDEMNIFICATION AND LIABILITY


