ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF GALIANA PLLC

A Professional Limited Liability Company

The Articles of Organization of Galiana PLLC are hereby established pursuant to the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 621, *Florida Statutes* (2023) and the Florida Revised Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 605, *Florida Statutes* (2023).

Article I Name

The name of this professional limited liability company is:

Galiana PLLC

Galiana PLLC is hereinafter "the Company."

Article II Principal Office and Mailing Address

The Company's initial principal place of business and mailing address is 12201 Southwest 121st Avenue, Miami, Florida 33186.

Article III Registered Agent


The name and address of the Company's registered agent is Ramon Maximo Galiana, Esq., 12201 Southwest 121st Avenue, Miami, Florida 33186.

Article IV Management of the Company

Article V Members

No person other than a professional service corporation, professional limited liability company, or an individual, each of which must be duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice law, shall be a Member of the Company.



Article VI Alienation of Ownership Interests

No Member may sell or transfer their ownership interest in the Company except to another professional corporation, professional limited liability company, or individual, each of which must be eligible to be a Member of the Company pursuant to Article V. Any such sales or transfers must also comply with the Company's Operating Agreement.

Article VII Commencement of Existence and Duration

The Company's existence will commence on the date of filing of these Articles of Organization with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida. The Company shall have a perpetual duration.

Article VIII Purpose

The Company's purpose is to provide legal services as attorneys-at-law and to engage in any other reasonably related lawful activities that may be engaged in by a professional limited liability company under the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 621, *Florida Statutes* (2023).

Article IX Powers

The Company shall have all the powers granted to professional limited liability companies by the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 621, *Florida Statutes* (2023), except that the Company shall not have the power to engage in any business other than the practice of law and reasonably related activities. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Company may invest its funds in bonds, stocks, mortgages, real estate, or other types of investments. The Company may own any real or personal property that is necessary or convenient to achieve the Company's purposes, as set forth in these Articles.
