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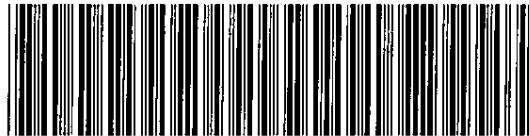

THIRD: The filing date of the articles of incorporation was October 31, 1989.



FIFTH: Dissolution of the Corporation shall become effective upon the filing of these Articles of Dissolution with the Florida Department of State.


