ARTICLE VI LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY REGULATIONS

ARTICLE IX MEMBERS RIGHTS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

The right, if given, of the remaining members of the limited liability company to continue the business on the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company shall be upon unanimous approval of all remaining members of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE X DISTRIBUTION OF PROPERTY

The limited liability company may, from time to time, distribute its property to its members in accordance with the provisions contained in the regulations, except that no distribution may be made if after the distribution the limited liability company would not be able to pay its debts as they become due in the usual course of business, or the limited liability company's total assets would be less than the sum of its total liabilities (except liabilities to members on account of their contributions, unless otherwise provided in the articles of organization). If the regulations do not provide for the payment of distributions to members, the distributions, when made, must be allocated on the basis of each member's relative capital account.
