The undersigned subscribe to these Articles of Organization to form a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act.

ARTICLE I

The name of this limited liability company shall be **JSE ACCEPTANCE COMPANY, L.C.**

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which this limited liability company has been organized is:

- A. To engage in the State of Florida in the acquisition and leasing of personal property and equipment including, without limitation, to invest in, acquire, hold, maintain, operate, own, lease, improve, sell, exchange, mortgage, encumber and otherwise use personal property for profit, to engage in any and all activities related or incidental thereto, and to engage in the financing of personal property, equipment and business enterprises.
- B. To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the purposes enumerated in these Articles of Organization, or any amendment thereof.
