ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this limited liability company is The Launch Support Company, L. C. (the "Company").

ARTICLE II - EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of dissolution of the Company shall begin on April 16, 2001.

ARTICLE III - DESCRIPTION

The Company, a joint venture between EG&G Florida, Inc. and Johnson Controls World Services Inc., was formed for the expressed purpose to pursue business opportunities with the National Aeronautic Space Administration and the United States Air Force under a program called the Joint Operations and Support Contract.
