1. Company Name:

The company name will be Innovations In Imaging, L.C. (hereinafter referred to as The Company) a limited liability company organized under the laws of the state of Florida, Florida Statutes 608.401 et seq. The initial members of The Company (hereinafter known as the Initial Members) will be Dataflow, Inc. a Corporation formed under the laws of New York State (hereinafter known as Dataflow) and Clifford Keller (hereinafter known as Keller), an individual.

2. Duration of Company:

The duration of The Company will be in perpetuity or until dissolved in accordance with the provisions for dissolution specified below in 14, Dissolution of Company.

3. Purpose of Company:

The Company is organized to make a profit primarily selling and producing large format color prints and related services (including but not limited to digital imaging, print and web-site design, and image archiving) and products (such as related material and equipment sales, and trade show display booths).

3.1 Powers Granted to Accomplish Purposes:
