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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION FOR BOCK GALLERY, LC

(A Florida Limited Liability Company)

SECRETARY OF STATE OF STATE OF CORPORATION

Following Chapter 608 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned does hereby submit these Articles of Organization for forming a Florida Limited Liability Company.

Article 1: Name and Principal Office

The name of the limited liability company is **Bock Gallery**, LC. The limited liability company's principal place of business and its mailing address is 1904-A Hollywood Blvd., Hollywood, FL 33020

Article 2: Duration

The duration of the limited liability company is perpetual.

Article 3: Purpose

The limited liability company will engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the laws of Florida.

Article 4: Registered Agent and Registered Office

The name of the limited liability company's first registered agent is Christy Bock., and her address is 1904-A Hollywood Blvd., Hollywood, FL 33020.

As registered agent, Christy Bock accepts service of process for the above limited liability company at the place designated in these articles of organization. Any entity that becomes a member of the limited liability company will have all rights and obligations of a member under the limited liability company operating agreement.

Article 11: Members Rights to Continue the Business

If a member dies, retires, resigns, declares bankruptcy, dissolves, or otherwise terminates continued membership in the limited liability company, the remaining members will continue the limited liability company based upon the contributions to the limited liability company as noted in Article V of the Articles of Organization, including amendments to Article V of the Articles of Organization.
