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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION FOR FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

CASA COUNTRY ITALIAN FURNITURE, L.L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the limited liability company is: Casa Country Italian Furniture, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the limited liability company is: 540 Brickell Key Drive, Suite 301, Miami (Miami-Dade County), Florida 33131.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purpose for which the limited liability company is formed is to engage in the importation of customized antique Italian furniture, as well as any lawful acts or activities for which limited liability companies may be formed, under Chapter 608 of the Statutes of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV DURATION

The limited liability company shall commence its existence, effective as of the 28th day of August, 1998. The period of duration for the limited liability company shall be seventy-five (75) years.

ARTICLE V REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE VI MANAGEMENT

The limited liability company is to be managed by managers, whose names and addresses are:

Karen L. Varela, Esq. 540 Brickell Key Drive, Suite 301 Miami, Florida 33131.

ARTICLE VII ADMISSION OF MEMBERS

New members may be admitted by the unanimous vote and upon such terms, as the then current members of the limited liability company may determine at the time of the application by or on behalf of a proposed new member.

ARTICLE VIII CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

The members of the limited liability company shall make additional capital contributions to the limited liability company, only upon the unanimous consent of the current members at that time. Profits and losses shall be allocated to the respective members of the limited liability company, as provided in the Regulations, duly adopted and as amended from time to sime by the members.

ARTICLE IX MEMBERS' RIGHTS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

Consistent with the Regulations, the remaining members of the limited liability company shall have the right to continue the business of the limited liability company upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event, which would ordinarily terminate the continued membership of a member of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE X INDEMNIFICATION

- (A) The limited liability company shall indemnify any person, who is or was a party, or who is threatened to be made a party, to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, including all appeals, by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a member, managing member or employee of the limited liability company, or is or was serving at the request of the limited liability company as a director. trustee, officer or employee of another limited liability company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against any and all expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees), judgments, decrees, fines, penalties and amounts paid in settlement, which were actually and reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with such action, suit or proceeding, if he or she acted in good faith and in a manner which he or she reasonably believed to be in, or at least not opposed to, the best interests of the limited liability company, and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, he or she had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful. The termination of any action, suit or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction, or plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent shall not, of itself, create a presumption that the person did not act in good faith and in a manner, which he or she reasonably believed to be in, or at least not opposed to, the best interests of the limited liability company.
- (B) The foregoing indemnification shall not apply in the case of an action, suit or proceeding instituted by one or more members of the limited liability company, if the claim, matter or issue raised therein is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to have resulted from the negligence or misconduct of the member(s) seeking indemnification; provided, however, that such indemnification shall nonetheless apply if, in view of all of the circumstances of the case, such court shall determine that such member(s) is/are fairly and reasonably entitled to indemnification, with respect to such expenses, judgments, decrees, fines, penalties and amounts paid in settlement, as determined by such court.
- (C) Expenses of each person indemnified hereunder, incurred in defending against a civil, criminal, administrative or investigative action, suit or proceeding (including all appeals), or threat thereof, may be paid by the limited liability company in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding, as authorized by a majority in interest of the members, upon receipt of an undertaking by such person to repay such amount, unless it shall ultimately be determined that he or she is entitled to be indemnified by the limited liability company.

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ARTICLE XI AMENDMENT

These Articles of Organization may only be amended, in accordance with the Regulations.
