ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF IntelSys Technologica, LLC

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this limited liability company shall be:
IntelSys Technologica, LLC

ARTICLE II DURATION

This company shall commence its existence on the date of execution and acknowledgement of these Articles of Organization, and shall exist for a period of twenty-nine (29) years.

ARTICLE III PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS
