ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF PATHLIGHTER, LLC

The undersigned certifies that he is authorized to execute and file these Articles for the purpose of establishing a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. I further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE I NAME AND ADDRESS
