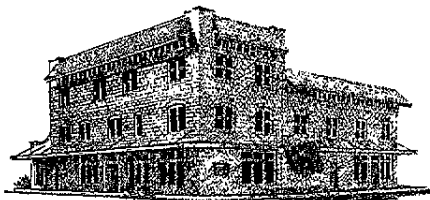


3. All debts, obligations, and liabilities of the Company have been paid or discharged.

6. The dissolution of the Company shall be effective upon filing these Articles of Dissolution with the Florida Department of State.






