ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF PROFESSIONAL LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this Professional Limited Liability Company is LANSKY & COURTNEY, P.L.

ARTICLE II DURATION
