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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF

Artistic Interiors (circa 2000), LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the limited liability company shall be Artistic Interiors (circa 2000), LLC (herein "Company").

ARTICLE IV - Managers
