It has come to my attention you have not received an Application by Foreign Limited Liability Company for Authorization to Transact Business in Florida. Please forgive this oversight.

In April and May of 1999, I contacted various Florida agencies in anticipation of Charlson Broadcast Technologies, LLC (CBT) beginning some activities in Florida as a seasonal vendor (see attached). Among these were the Florida Department of Revenue and the Florida Division of Pari- Mutual Wagering (See attached Memo(s)). In May of 1999 CBT began activities in Florida; those activities consist of providing video broadcasting for Calder Race Course, allowing, among other things, interstate simulcasting of racing signals.

Since beginning the activities in Florida, CBT has been diligent in filing all tax returns it was aware were applicable, and promptly paying all related taxes. This would include all payroll and sales tax, racing licensing, personal property tax and income taxes. To date, CBT has paid \$77,150.80 in personal property taxes alone.

Please note on 4/13/99 I contacted (800) 488-9000 and requested forms to register to do business in the State of Florida. On 5/13/99 I filed the forms sent -an Application to Collect Taxes, noting CBT was a new business. Since that time, despite filing all tax returns and paying all related taxes, CBT, LLC has not received notice of a failure to make any required application or registration to do business. I would have expected that if the company had been remiss in any filing we would have received notice; had we

received such notice, the company would certainly have promptly complied with any applicable application or registration.

Given the above facts and circumstances, I would respectively request any penalties for late filing or late payment of fees be waived. I assure you CBT will continue to comply with all regulations as we know them.

Please accept the attached Application and excuse the inadvertent delay in filing.

Re: Florida Sales/ Use Tax

On 4/2/99 CDR contacted the Florida Department of Revenue, ((850) 922-9645) inquiring of steps to take to register for sales tax numbers in Florida. CDR explained the nature of the business CBT would be doing in Florida, ie Calder Race Track filming.

CDR was advised the Department would send CBT a DRI application for sales tax registration. CDR asked that the department also send info, ie. booklets, explaining Florida sales tax regulations.

On 4/13/99 CDR again contacted the Dept of Revenue at the above phone number and spoke to Gayle. Gayle explained that when CBT purchases items not for resale, CBT is responsible for paying sales tax to the vendor. If however, CBT is reselling and not purchasing the item for its own use, CBT needs to provide its vendor with its Florida sales tax number in order to avoid paying sales tax on its purchase.

CDR explained that CBT does in fact purchase items not for its own direct use but does not separately bill its customers for sales tax; instead, the contracted price includes a sales tax component. CDR mentioned to Gayle that it is the local track practice to remit use tax to the state for a percentage (designed to relate to equipment usage) of amounts paid CBT. Gayle noted the Florida track can provide CBT with a copy of its self- accruing tax authority letter & thus absolve CBT from collecting sales tax. Gayle speculated the Florida track would have received such a letter from the Florida Dept. of Revenue.

On 5/13/99 CDR contacted Alice Yates of the Florida Dept of Revenue who promised that if CDR would overnight the Fl Application to Collect Tax in Florida she would expedite the application and call me 5/14/99 with a sales tax number. CDR has completed the application and is 5/13/99 overnighting the application to Ms. Yates.

5/14/99 CDR spoke a couple of times to Alice Yates who was kind enough to request her supervisors make an exception and allow her to verbally today assign a sales tax number. CDR faxed requested info to Alice who called back with a sales tax number. That is 23-08-496098-32.

Re: On 4/2/99 CDR left message for Maria Reeves((800) 482-8293 of the Florida Department of Labor to determine steps required to apply for Florida payroll tax numbers/ registration.

On 4/5/99 Maria Reeves (direct phone line (850)921-5029) who promised to send registration sheets for application for Florida unemployment insurance tax registration. Martha during the phone conversation assigned CBT a UC number of 218811-7.

Martha noted Florida does not have an income tax.

5/25/99 9:30 AM, CDR contacted the Fl Dept of Revenue re. local sales tax issues. Per representative of that department, there is no local city or county income tax imposed on persons working in Miami/ Dade County.

Re; Registration to do business in Florida

CDR on 4/2/99 requested the Department ((850) 488-9000) mail CBT registration forms.

Re: Workers Compensation coverage

Re: CDR contacted Florida at (850) 488-3030 or (850) 488-2031 re workers compensation coverage for Florida employees. The Department promised to send CDR information regarding same but noted coverage in Florida. is provided via insurance obtained by the employer from any insurance company

Re: Florida Professional Regulation Individual Occupational License Application Florida Division of Pari- Mutual Wagering

I spoke to Jane Miller of the Florida Division of Pari- Mutual Wagering (850) 488-9161

Per Jane, companies and individuals can apply for one or three year licenses- no dollar savings but a convenience factor. Jane suggested CBT not apply until 5/1/99, as a license we would apply for in April would expire 6/30/99 and the annual fees would not be prorated and therefore it would be wise to apply post 5/1/99.

(CDR placed a call for Jane 5/7/99 to verify our people would have license to work at the track 5/99 with the license application of post 5/1/99. Left a message for her to call CDR)

CDR mentioned CBT is a LLC and Jane noted not every shareholder / director must have an individual license; it is sufficient for the managing partner to have a individual license.

Persons can go to the office at the track to get licenses. Fees should be sent to the state inspection office at the track. Any questions, call Paul Boroff, chief inspector, at (305) 625-1311 Ext 3224 or 3326.

Jane has sent some fingerprint cards for CBT and noted any track will fingerprint usually at no charge.

Per Paul, he will call Calder and tell them to license CBT if CBT presents the orange Company licensing application and CCharlson's application and fingerprint.

5/25/99 Because of the turnover CBT is experiencing, CDR called Jane Miller with question @ necessity of getting licensed first day of work. CDR first thanked her for her

assistance in getting CBT's LLC license. licenses the first day of work.
