Florida law requires the registered office address to be a Florida street address.

Our records further reflect that the above referenced entity is delinquent in filing its 2009 Annual Report form. The 2009 Annual Report form was due on or before May 1, 2009. Please correct the above referenced deficiency when you file your 2009 Annual Report form.

Effective January 1, 2009, all Annual Report filings must be entered and submitted electronically online. To file your Annual Report, simply go to our website, [www.sunbiz.org](http://www.sunbiz.org), and click on the blue box entitled "File the 2009 Annual Report or Amended Annual Report Here," which is located in the middle of the page. Next, enter the entity's Florida document or registration number in the appropriate box and click the "submit" button.

Annual Report payments can be made by credit card, debit card, or by check or money order. For credit card and debit card processing allow 2-3 days; if paying by check or money order allow 3-5 weeks. An Annual Report will be processed and posted after the credit card or debit card payment is confirmed or when the check or money order and the required payment voucher are received and processed by our office. All payment options will display after you complete and submit your Annual Report online.

A \$400 late fee in addition to the required filing fee is due after May 1st. However, the Division of Corporations may abate the \$400 late fee if the above referenced entity or the person responsible for filing the annual report for said entity did not receive the first notice in a timely manner. Annual reports are due between January 1 and May 1 of every year. The first notices are either mailed to the entity's last known mailing address via the US Postal Service or electronically

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sent to the entity's last known email address the first week of January every year.

If the entity or the person responsible for filing the above referenced entity's annual report did not receive the notice in a timely fashion and wishes to have the \$400 late fee abated, you must check the box on the online annual report filing form to indicate the business entity did not receive the first annual report notice. This box is located under the required signature block in the yellow shaded area. The yellow shaded area contains the following statements: After May 1st of each year, a late charge of \$400 is imposed, except in circumstances in which the entity did not receive prior notice. Please check this box if notice was not received.

A \$400 late fee will be imposed if the box is not checked.
