To whom it may concern,

I have received this notice of Administrative Dissolution or Revocation.

I asked my daughter to call your office and resolve the problem and they told her to send you a letter explaining what happened and asking for you to revoke the \$600.00 fee and to enclose a check for the normal \$150.00 fee and that I will receive an answer from you if you accept.

The pharmacy has not received from you any mail at all, neither an application nor any notices. I work in the pharmacy alone, it is a very small pharmacy. I do not have any employees that may have taken it. My daughter does not work with me physically every month of the year as she did two years ago. I am 76 years old and I have been filing these reports every year. There is no way I could have missed it. It is a very easy document to recognize: it is a white paper with green lines on it. I never had any problems with any licenses of any kind. I always pay whatever I receive, not matter what license it is. Sometimes I pay twice. If I receive a document that I do not understand, I simply fax it to my daughter in California or mail it by FedEx and I make sure that she actually receives it. I forwarded this notice of reinstatement to her and asked her to check her files for the papers and she has not received any notice that I might have forwarded to her from you. She came to Florida in December and worked with any pending papers and she did not see it.

The only explanation that I see for the loss of the application is that at the end of last year I went to the Post Office Main Branch and talked to the manager. The problem was that I was missing an invoice that a pharmaceutical company had sent me several times within the same month. I did not notice any other papers missing but who knows. I had an argument with the mailman because he kept parking his truck in the only parking space that I am given for my customers. There are only eleven parking spaces in the entire shopping center and most of them are taken by the cafeteria next door. He was very angry ,upset and rude with me for quite a while whenever he delivered the mail. Then I started noticing the missing invoices and that is when I believe that he started throwing away some of my mail and not delivering it. My daughter also called the Post Office and the manager told her that he could have discarded my letters on purpose. Later he was taken off this route. The problem is that I do not know when it happened exactly. All I know is that is that it was at the end of this last year or the beginning of this one. But that still does not explain why I have not received any second notice. One explanation is that maybe the letters could have been delivered to the cafeteria next door. I have received letters in my mail box that belong to them and it happens very often, several times a week. This is due to the fact that the senders does not specify whether it is 553-A or 553-B and even if they do, the mailman very often doesn't pay attention to it. The cafeteria also gets much of my mail. The mail boxes are next to each other and sometimes people pick up the mail for them, even a drunk client. Some of their own mail may have been lost, misplaced or even stolen.
