## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Approximately one week ago I was hand delivered this packet, along with a few other pieces of mail by the manager of the apartments where I previously lived and received my mail. When I opened the packet and looked at the dates and old address, I was shocked. I moved to my current address over a year ago and changed my mailing address with the post office; and I thought I did the same with all correspondents.

For some unknown reason I still get one or two pieces of mail hand delivered to the managers office at the old address rather than forwarded to me or returned to sender. Nevertheless, I never received your packet until just before Christmas; and what a Christmas present it was.

I have kept this very small company a float for over ten years now to earn some extra income, usually a couple of thousand dollars a year to supplement social security these past two years. I have never earned over a few thousand dollars that I can remember and some years less than that. I

enjoy the work that I do as well as the few extra dollars income. This year the business will probably lose money due to expenses that were not incurred before. In 1998 I was forced for the first time in securing liability insurance that was approximately \$500.00. It may sound silly to think that \$500.00 may have been the difference this year between making a profit or showing a loss, but it is so. If it becomes necessary to pay an additional \$500.00 or so to keep the corporation, I will either have to drop the corporation, which I don't want to do, or consider what alternatives I have to keep this little business going.
