ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

A Florida Corporation Not for Profit

I, the undersigned, acting as incorporator of the non-profit corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation (hereinafter called the association) is THINK FIRST INJURY PREVENTION OF CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

This association is organized for the purpose of operating an educational foundation, charitable foundation and/or enterprise.

In furtherance of such purposes, the association shall have the power to:

- (a) Affix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means of all charges, assessments and dues needed by it in order to carry out its duties.
- (b) Acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, and improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate to public use, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property in connection with the affairs of the corporation;
- (c) Borrow money, and subject to the consent by vote or written statement of two-thirds

(2/3) of the Board of Directors, mortgage, pledge, convey by deed of trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;

(d) Dedicate, sell, or transfer all or any part of its property to any municipality, public agency, authority, or utility for such purposes and subject to such conditions as may be agreed upon by the Board of Directors. No such dedication or transfer shall be effective unless an instrument has been signed by two-thirds (2/3) of the Board of Directors, agreeing to such dedication, sale or transfer;

(e) Participate in mergers and consolidations with other non-profit corporations organized for the same purposes, provided that any merger, consolidation, shall have the assent by vote or written instrument of two-thirds (2/3) of the Board of Directors;

(f) Have and exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges that a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes by law may or hereafter have or exercise.

The association is organized and shall be operated exclusively for the purposes set forth above. The activities of the association may be financed by assessments against the members and/or donations from the public. No part of any net earnings or assets of the association will inure to the benefit of any member.

ARTICLE IV

The qualifications of members and the manner of their admission shall be as regulated by the bylaws.

ARTICLE V

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 1881 N. Frazier Terrace, Hernando, Florida 34442 and the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address

is Twyla Gronert. This is also the principal office for the corporation.

ARTICLE VI

The number of persons constituting the first Board of Directors shall be one and her names and addresses are as follows:
