ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF

EL CAMBA HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

A Florida Corporation Not For Profit

The undersigned incorporator(s), for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida not for profit corporation act, Florida statutes, chapter 617, hereby adopt(s) the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

El Camba Homeowners Association, Inc.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be:

1841 George Jenkins Blvd. Lakeland, Florida 33815

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the date of execution and acknowledgment of these articles.

ARTICLE III - CORPORATE PURPOSES

The purpose for which this corporation is formed: To conduct legal, business and recreational activities for the homeowners of El Camba Mobile Home Association and for such other purposes as are permitted by a corporation which is exempt from federal income tax under section 501(C)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, (or corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue law) and will further the foregoing purposes.

ARTICLE IV - LIMITATIONS

The corporation shall neither have nor issue any stock. The corporation shall not, as a substantial part of it's activities, carry on propaganda of otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated for the purposes specified in article III above. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to it's members, directors of officers or other private persons, but the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article III hereof. The corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by: (A) A corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(C)(3) OR 501(C)(4) or both under the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (of the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue law); or (B) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(C)(2) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

ARTICLE V - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, no member, director, or private person, corporate or individual, or other private interest shall be entitled to any distribution of it's remaining funds and other property. The balance of such funds and property shall, after the payment of all debt, and liabilities of the corporation be distributed to an organization operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (of the corresponding provision of any United States Internal Revenue law), as shall be provided by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI - DISTRIBUTION OF INCOME

This corporation shall distribute it's income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by section 4942 of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue law). This corporation shall not:

- (A) Engage in any act of self dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue law);
- (B) Retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (of the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue law);
- (C) Make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue law); or
- (D) Make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue law).

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ARTICLE VII - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE

AND RESIDENT AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 316 El Camba M.H.P., Lakeland, Fl. 33815. The name of the initial registered agent at that address is Frances Siemen.

ARTICLE VIII - INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the incorporator of the corporation is:

ARTICLE IX - MEMBERS

The qualifications for members of the corporation and the manner of their admission shall be as regulated by the bylaws of the corporation. The initial members shall be the initial Board of Directors.

ARTICLE X - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The management of the corporation shall be vested in it's Board of Directors. The election of directors shall be by the members as provided in the bylaws of the corporation. There shall be six (6) initial directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3). Directors of this corporation shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities, or obligations of the corporation, and shall not be subject to any assessments. The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these articles or any amendment to them. Amendments to the articles of incorporation may be proposed by any Director and may be adopted by the majority vote of the members.
