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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SUNCOAST SINGLES, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of Florida Statutes 617, the undersigned, all of whom are residents of Pasco County, Florida, and all of whom are of full age, have this day voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit and do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is Suncoast Singles, Inc., hereinafter called the "Corporation".

ARTICLE II.

The principal office of the Corporation is located at 5713 Salt Kettle Court, New Port Richey, Florida 34652.

ARTICLE III.

Regina Corke, whose address is 5713 Salt Kettle Court, New Port Richey, Florida 34652, is hereby appointed the initial registered agent of this Corporation.

ARTICLE IV.

This Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for social functions and events for single adults and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the members and guests of the corporation as may hereafter be brought within the jurisdiction of this Corporation for this purpose to:

(a) Fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the By-Laws; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Corporation, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Corporation;

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- (b) Acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Corporation;
- (c) Borrow money, and with the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of the voting members mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;
- (d) Participate in mergers and consolidations with other non-profit corporations organized for the same purposes provided that any such merger, consolidation or annexation shall have the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of the members;
- (e) Have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the non-profit corporation law of the State of Florida by law may now or hereafter have or exercise.

ARTICLE V.

The affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by a Board of four (4) Directors who are members of the Corporation. The number of Directors may be changed by amendment of the By-Laws of the Corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are to act in the capacity of Directors until the selection of their successors are:

The affairs of this Corporation shall be administered by a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, who are members of the Corporation. The following persons shall act in the capacity indicated until the selection of their successors in accordance with the By-Laws of the Corporation.

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ARTICLE VII.

The name and address of the subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation for the Corporation is:

ARTICLE VIII.

The By-Laws of the Corporation will be adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the Board of Directors, all of who are members of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX.

The Corporation may be dissolved with the assent given in writing and signed by not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the members. Upon dissolution of the Corporation other than incident to a merger or consolidation, the assets of the Corporation shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which this Corporation was created. In the event that such dedication is refused acceptance, such assets shall be granted, conveyed and asigned to any nonprofit corporation, Corporation, trust or other organization to be devoted to such similar purposes.

ARTICLE X.

The corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE XI.

Amendment of these Articles shall require the assent of seventy-five (75%) percent of the entire membership.
