We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida applicable to corporations not for profit, and respectfully petition the Secretary of State for approval of such incorporation under the following proposed Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation is TWO EGG FOUNDATION, INC. The principal office for the corporation is 4884 Cape San Blas Road, Port St. Joe, FL 32456.

ARTICLE II DURATION

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual. Corporate existence shall commence upon the proper filing of these Articles in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

- A. The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, Florida Statutes Chapters 617 and 196, and Article VII, Section 3 of the Florida Constitution; and to raise and distribute contributions from individuals, corporations, governmental entities and foundations, for the benefit of art, music and education.
- B. The general purposes and powers are to have and to exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the laws of Florida, including the power to contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property; provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.
- C. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall n ot paticipate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publigation or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

This Corporation shall have no members, consequently it shall have no classes of membership, nor voting rights of members.

ARTICLE V REGISTERED AGENT

The initial registered agent for this corporation is THOMAS S. GIBSON, and the initial registered office is located at 206 East Fourth Street, Port St. Joe, FL 32456.
