# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

## CHURCH IN THE PINES, INC.

## 1. NAME AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE.

The name of the corporation is Church in the Pines, Inc., and the address of the Principal Office of the corporation is 66 Cuna Street, Suite A, St. Augustine, Florida 32084.

#### 2. PURPOSE.

The Corporation is organized as a Corporation not-for-profit under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to provide an entity responsible for the operation of a nondenominational church serving St. Johns County, Florida.

## 3. OUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS AND MANNER OF THEIR ADMISSION.

The Members of this Corporation shall constitute all of the Members of the Church. The initial Members of the Corporation shall be the Subscribers of the Corporation as described herein. Additional persons shall be accepted as Members by the approval of a majority of the existing Members of the Corporation. Such approval shall be made by a voice vote of a majority of the Members present at a duly called Members' meeting.

## 4. <u>TERM</u>.

The existence of the Corporation shall be perpetual unless the Corporation is terminated by the majority vote of all Members which vote shall be taken in person or by proxy at a duly called Members' meeting. In the event of such termination, the Corporation shall be dissolved in accordance with law.

#### 5. NAME AND ADDRESS OF SUBSCRIBER.

## 6. DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS.

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by its Board of Directors who shall be called the Vestry. The Officers of the Corporation shall be a Senior Warden, a Junior Warden, a Treasurer and a Secretary, which officers shall be elected annually by the Vestry. The Vestry and Officers may lawfully and properly exercise the powers set forth in Paragraph (11) hereof, notwithstanding the fact that some or all of them who may be directly or indirectly involved in the exercise of such powers and in the negotiation and consummation of any agreements executed pursuant to such powers are some or all of the persons with whom the Corporation enters into such agreements or who are employed by or own some or all of the proprietary interests in the entity or entities with whom the Corporation enters into such agreements.

## 7. NAME OF OFFICER.

The name of the officer who is to serve until the first election or appointment is as follows: Joyce Dupont; Senior Warden, Junior Warden and Secretary/Treasurer

#### 8. DIRECTORS (VESTRY).

The Vestry shall consist of not fewer than three (3) nor more than seven (7) persons, provided that the Vestry Members may consist of one (1) vestry member until the first election of the Vestry. The initial number of the Vestry shall be five (5). The number of Vestry members may be modified by the majority vote of the Members present in person or by proxy at a duly called Members' meeting. #### 9. BY-LAWS.

The original By-Laws shall be determined by the Vestry. The same may thereafter be amended by not fewer than a majority of the Vestry Members at a duly called Vestry meeting and by fifty (50%) percent plus one (1) of the Members present either in person or by proxy at a duly called Members' meeting.

#### 10. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES.

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended only with the approval of not fewer than a majority of the Vestry at a duly called Vestry meeting and fifty percent (50%) plus one (1) of the Members present either in person or by proxy at a duly called Members' meeting.

- 11. <u>POWERS</u>. The Corporation shall have all of the following powers:
- 1. To exercise all of the powers set forth and described in Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.
- 2. To acquire and enter into agreements whereby it acquires leaseholds, memberships or other possessory or use interests in lands or facilities whether or not contiguous to the lands of the Church, intended to provide for the worship needs, enjoyment, recreation, or other use of benefit of the Members.
- 3. To appoint and set the compensation for the minister and all other employees of the Corporation.
  - 4. To operate and manage the Church in accordance with the sense, meaning,

direction, purpose and intent of the these Articles of Incorporation as the same may from time to time be amended and to otherwise perform, fulfill and exercise the powers, privileges, options, rights, duties, obligations and responsibilities entrusted to or delegated to it by the Articles of Incorporation.

## 12. INDEMNIFICATION.

Every Vestry Member and Officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including legal counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him or her in connection with any proceeding or any settlement of any proceeding to which he or she may be a party, or in which he or she may become involved by reason of his or her being or having been a Vestry Member or Officer at the time said expenses are incurred. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such Vestry Member or Officer may be entitled.

#### 13. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT.
