ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

CONCILIO INTERNACIONAL DE IGLESIAS CRISTIANAS INDEPENDIENTES, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation, pursuant to the Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617 Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following articles of such corporation.

ARTICLE I NAME AND LOCATION

OF PUERTO RICO, INC. which is exempt as an organization described in Section (501(c) (3) and 170© (2) of the Internal Revenue Code PF 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to Federal State.

ARTICLE XI STOCK

Section 1:

Non-Profit Religious Corporation: The corporation shall be a non-profit corporation without stock or fixed capital and members of the corporation shall be those duly admitted to membership as specified in Article III.

ARTICLE XII ANNUAL MEETINGS

The annual meeting of the members shall be held in a place determined by the President and Board of Directors, as shall the time and date be determined by the same President and Board of Directors.
