

**AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ABRAHAM LINCOLN MULTI-PURPOSE LEARNING CENTER, INC.**

AMENDED ARTICLE III. NATURE/PURPOSE OF BUSINESS

The purpose for which the Abraham Lincoln Multi-Purpose Learning Center, Inc. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

AMENDED ARTICLE VI. TERM OF EXISTENCE

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501(c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.
