ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN
NEW SMYRNA BEACH BRANCH LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND
NEW SMYRNA BEACH, FLORIDA, INC.
(Nonprofit corporation)

BY THESE ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION, the incorporators form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is American Association of University Women New Smyrna Beach Branch Local Scholarship Fund, New Smyrna Beach, Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to:

- a. Raise and provide funds for scholarships to needy persons.
- b. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, and educational and purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE III - STOCK

The corporation shall issue no stock.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERS

This corporation shall have Members. Members of the corporation shall be those persons who are members of the New Smyrna Beach branch, American Association of University Women.

ARTICLE V - DIRECTORS

The corporation shall have a board of directors of four directors initially. The Bylaws of the corporation shall provide the method of election of directors and the manner in which vacancies shall be filled. The number of directors shall be

prescribed by the Bylaws from time to time.

ARTICLE VI - INCORPORATORS

ARTICLE VII - BYLAWS

The bylaws shall be adopted by the board of directors.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENTS

An amendment to these articles may be proposed by the board of directors or an officer or a member. Amendments shall be adopted by the board of directors by affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the directors present and voting at a meeting at which a quorum is present with the secretary entitled to cast two votes.

ARTICLE IX - ADDRESS

The initial post office address of the principal office of the corporation in the State of Florida is 335 North Causeway, No. D24, New Smyrna Beach, Florida 32169.

The board of directors from time to time may move the principal office to any other address in New Smyrna Beach, Florida.

ARTICLE X - RESIDENT AGENT

The initial registered agent of this corporation shall be Robert H. Bailey, Jr., Esquire, and the registered office of this corporation shall be located at 340 North Causeway, New Smyrna Beach, Florida 32169.

ARTICLE XI - MEMBERS MEETINGS

No act of the members shall be valid unless taken at a meeting of the members after notice as prescribed in the bylaws.

ARTICLE XII - EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any

future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE XIII - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, any proceeds being held by the corporation at that time, shall be conveyed to the American Association of University Women Educational Foundation, an organization that qualifies as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE XIV - NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

The corporation will be subordinate to and subject to the authority of the national head of the American Association of University Women.
