Articles of Restatement

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Women Writers of Haitian Descent, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principle place of business of this corporation shall be:

Article III PURPOSES(S)

The specific purpose(s) for which the organization is organized are:
To develop an institution to support and encourage women of Haitian descent in their published work, to educate the public about Haitian women's writing through, but not limited to, lectures, publications, literacy-oriented community projects, conferences, or otherwise.

This organization is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IV MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is:
The number of initial directors of this corporation shall be four (4). The initial directors are selected between the founders of WWOHD, Inc. for a period of three years. At the end of this period, the Director will be selected by vote by the organization's active members.

Article VII ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation [except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code], and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.
