ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a not-for-profit corporation, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be:

ST. RAPHAEL, ST. NICHOLAS & ST. IRENE HELLENIC ORTHODOX CHURCH, INC.

The address of the principal office of this corporation shall be 110 Park Avenue, Tarpon Springs, Florida 34689, and the mailing address of the corporation shall be the same.

ARTICLE II
