ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
KOREAN OPEN DOOR BAPTIST CHURCH, INC.

We, the undersigned, having formed a Church and desirous of being chartered under the Laws of Florida as a recorded corporation, and by the authority of the Statute of Florida under Chapter 617.02 of the Laws of Florida as Amended, do hereby join together to form a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be KOREAN OPEN DOOR BAPTIST CHURCH, INC. and shall be situate at 720 Faith Street, Maitland, Florida 32751, doing business as KOREAN OPEN DOOR BAPTIST CHURCH, INC., mailing address of 720 Faith Street, Maitland, Florida 32751.

ARTICLE II

The general nature and object of the corporation is worship Almighty God and to pursue the cause of evangelism in the name of Jesus Christ and to advise, give counsel and propose measures for the advancement of the cause of Jesus Christ a missionary Baptist Church in the vicinity of Orange County, Florida, autonomously acting as the KOREAN OPEN DOOR BAPTIST CHURCH, INC., notwithstanding the hereinafter reference to our present and future association with the Southern Baptist Convention, Inc. and the Florida Baptist Convention, together with and including the following purposes:

- (a) To assist in the organization of new churches, Sunday Schools and missions;
- (b) To establish and conduct other institutions of religious, educational, charitable and/or benevolent character;
- (c) To buy, acquire, own, encumber, owe, sell or trade both real and personal property and to deal generally in real estate as appears necessary to promote the gospel of Jesus Christ at the home church and otherwise.

ARTICLE III

The membership of the corporation shall consist of those persons who each in turn, publicly professes faith in Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord, and who upon receiving a majority of the affirmative vote of members present and voting, thereafter follows Him in Scriptural baptism, or transfer of membership from a Church of similar faith or who is accepted upon their statement of prior Christian experience and baptism.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless otherwise dissolved in the same manner as hereinafter set out for amendment to the Charter and/or By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

The officers of the beginning corporation and who shall hold office for one(1) year or until reelected by the Church in the manner set out for elections, shall be as follows:

(a) The interim trustees who are acting as Trustees of the corporation for one(1) year or until replaced shall be the above named; that the church may by a meeting and majority vote of the members of the church corporation, elect additional deacons to act as directors, which directors together with the abovenamed officers, shall serve as the Board of Directors until otherwise provided by By-Laws adopted by the corporation.

(b) The business affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the church body who shall operate autonomously with recommendations, guidance and counsel from the body of deacons who shall act as a Board of Directors whose recommendations from the Church Council, Church Officers, appropriate committees or members as from time to time appearing necessary under the By-laws of the corporation, thereby all matters of whatever kind or nature having to do with the business transactions, financial matters, conveyances, encumbrances, and any and all matters of business and/or operation shall be by the direction of the church body which may act upon an appropriate resolution evidenced by the Minutes of the Board of Directors but not limited to such recommendations for that the government of the corporation shall be by the autonomous operation of the church acting upon a majority vote of the members; any action, movement or operation by way of recommendation from the Board of Directors, church council, or committee, shall be subscribed by the Chairman of said body and attested by the church clerk or the secretary of deacons in the absence of the church clerk, then acting as secretary of the corporation.

(c) The Trustees shall act in such a manner as necessary to hold and/or encumber property until such time as the Church has elected its Board of Directors as set out in paragraph (d).

(d) The Board of Directors shall consist of the deacons acting in an advisory capacity.

(e) All checks, bills, or drafts necessary in current operation of the business shall be subscribed by such person or persons as are from time to time authorized on the checking account by current resolution of the corporation and no checks, bills or drafts shall at any time be executed or subscribed except the same shall be properly entered in the corporation checkbook and properly charged in the records of the corporation under such headings as are from time to time designated.

(f) The names of the officers who are holding office and shall continue to hold office for one(1) year or until replaced at or after one year from date, are the above set out officers.

ARTICLE VI

The Articles of Incorporation as henceforth, may be adopted, may be made, altered or rescinded upon a two-thirds vote of the members present at any designated meeting of the corporation, provided the said amendment or amendments shall be first read to the church body at no less than two business meetings of the corporation, having been posted on the office bulletin board during the interim between the said meetings.

ARTICLE VII

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may, at any time subject itself, shall not exceed the aggregate of the then value added together with the value of the proposed addition unless and except the same shall be endorsed by two-thirds of the membership existing at the time of a resolution concerning indebtedness in excess of the value of the property of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

The corporation shall be limited in the amount and/or value of the real estate which the corporation may hold except as provided by law.

ARTICLE IX

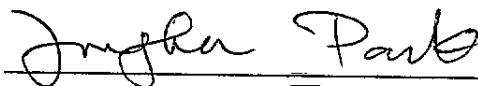
In the event the corporation shall dissolve, disband or shall cease to operate as a church corporation, no disbursement of assets may be made to any member of the corporation nor shall the proceeds of the property of the corporation be disbursed to the membership or any of them but on the contrary,

all of the items of value, both real and personal, furniture, fixtures, any and all items whatsoever, shall be and become the property of Greater Orlando Baptist Association.

ARTICLE X

The Resident Agent until replaced or elected by a successor who shall agree to accept the position of Resident Agent, shall be Jongha Park, 720 Faith Street, Maitland, Florida 32751. who hereinafter subscribes in a dual capacity as President, subscriber and resident agent and as resident agent, states that he is familiar with and accepts the duties and responsibilities as resident agent for said corporation.
