ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
PANHANDLE HUMAN DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

ARTICLE I

Name: The name of this corporation is *PANHANDLE HUMAN DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, INC.* a corporation not-for-profit.

ARTICLE II

Duration: This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of this filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State.

ARTICLE III

Purpose: To expand & improve the economic, educational, social, cultural & physical health of those citizens residing in Northwest Florida.

ARTICLE IV

Qualification of Members: Persons indicating a desire to be part of this organization, and demonstrating an ability to contribute to the purposes of this organization and receiving a simple majority approval of the board will then be made a part of the general membership.

ARTICLE V

Initial Registered Office and Agent: The address of the initial registered office of this corporation at Highway, Route #2, Box 139, Quincy, Florida 32351, and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation is James Smith.

ARTICLE VI

Incorporators: The names and addresses of the Incorporator/s signing these articles are:

ARTICLE VII

Initial Board of Directors: This corporation shall have three (5) directors constituting the initial Board of Directors. The number of directors may be either increased from time to time by the Bylaws but in no event shall they be less than three (3). ARTICLE VIII

Board of Directors elections: The Board of Directors shall be elected by the existing Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX

Officers: The legal affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the officers who shall be elected at the annual meeting each year to serve for the ensuing year. The officers of the corporation shall serve until their respective successors in office shall be elected and duly qualified.

ARTICLE X

Revenue: No part of the net-earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. The corporation shall not in any way, directly or indirectly, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, or participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, by publishing or distributing statements or otherwise. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any further United States Revenue Law).

ARTICLE XI

Dissolution: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the disposal of the corporation in such manner, or to organization of organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
