**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation is International Pentecostal City Mission Church of Ocala, Inc. The principal address is 9584 Maricamp Rd. Ocala, Florida, 34472.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The Corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This Corporation shall be authorized to exercise the powers permitted non-profit corporations under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes; provided, however, that this Corporation in exercising any one or more of such powers shall do so in furtherance of the exempt purpose for which it has been organized as described in §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
