ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

EDUCATION FOUNDATION OF

POLK EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (1990), adopt the following articles of incorporation and state as follows:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is "Education Foundation of Polk Education Association, Inc.". The initial principal place of business and mailing address will be 730 East Davidson Street, Bartow, Florida 33830.

ARTICLE II

Duration

This corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICL<u>E</u> III

Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of developing and expanding the educational opportunities for children who are the offspring of Polk Education Association members and to fund classroom grants and scholarships for employees who are seeking degrees to become members of the teacher's bargaining unit in Polk County, Florida. Members in good standing of the Polk Education Association, a tax exempt organization pursuant to Section 501(c) (8) of the Internal Revenue code, as amended, whose offspring satisfy scholastic requirements and attend accredited post-secondary institutions of learning, are entitled to permit such offspring to apply and compete for scholarship benefits to be paid directly to the institution's financial office to be applied to tuition, books and other educational costs. Employees in good standing of the School Board of Polk County who satisfy scholastic requirements and attend accredited post-

secondary institutions for the purpose of becoming educators are also entitled to apply and compete for scholarship benefits to be paid directly to the institution's financial office to be applied to tuition, books and other educational costs. In furtherance of such objectives, the corporation is authorized to solicit and receive private and public contributions to provide funds for the administration of the aforesaid educational assistance and to receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, and to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, literary or educational purposes either directly or by contribution to other organizations which qualify as exempt organizations pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended.

ARTICLE IV

Membership

The membership in this corporation shall consist of the Board of Directors and any other persons who may be admitted as members in accordance with the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VI

Board of Directors

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a governing board called the Board of Directors. Members of the Board of Directors shall be appointed by the President of the Polk Education Association and need not be members of that organization. The Board of Directors may select an executive committee and other officers in accordance with the By-Laws. The corporation may provide in its By-Laws for ex-officio members to serve on the Board. Such ex-officio members shall have the powers enumerated in the By-Laws of the corporation. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of the following persons:

ARTICLE X

By-Laws

The By-Laws of the corporation may be made, altered or rescinded from time to time at any regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Directors present and voting provided that written notice of any proposed amendment has been given to the Directors not later than the previous meeting of the Board of Directors and provided, further, that no change shall be made which will adversely affect this corporation's tax exempt status.

Article XI

Amendment to Articles of Incorporation

These articles of incorporation may be amended from time to time at any regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the directors present and voting provided that written notice of each proposed amendment has been given to the Directors not later than the previous meeting of the Board of Directors.

Dissolution




