ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JumpStart Program, Inc.



I, the undersigned, do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of clarifying the establishing a corporation not for profit, under the provisions of Chapter 617, Laws of Florida and section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation will be JumpStart Program, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The general purpose for which this corporation is: JumpStart Program, Inc. is a non-profit corporation providing a Charter School, Parent Education Center, and Resource Center.

JumpStart Program/is an educational and therapeutic program committed to educating and therapeutically treating children with communications and learning disorders and their families through cutting edge education, support, resources and advocacy. JumpStart Program has set out to be a replicable national model for reasonable and practical modifications to insure inclusion works. This is being done by insuring that it is an effective and successful model of educational programming, which provides, as much as reasonable, full inclusion of children with a variety of communications and learning disorders with typically developing peers and classmates

ARTICLE III

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

ARTICLE V

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. ARTICLE VI

Upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or

shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.
