

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
TRIPLE CROSS YOUTH MINISTRIES, INC.**

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE I NAME**

The name of the corporation shall be TRIPLE CROSS YOUTH MINISTRIES, INC. hereinafter referred to as the "Association", or the "Corporation".

**ARTICLE II TERM**

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

**ARTICLE III PURPOSE**

The general purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

1. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
2. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Association shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

**ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS**

A. The affairs and property of the corporation shall be managed and governed by a Board of Directors. The initial Board of Directors shall have three (3) members, and the number of directors on subsequent Boards will be determined from time to time in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws of the Association.

B. Directors shall be elected by the voting members in accordance with the By-Laws at regular annual meetings of the membership of the Association, in the manner set out by the By-Laws. Directors shall be elected to serve for a term of one (1) year. In the event of a vacancy, the elected directors may appoint an additional director to serve the balance of the term

C. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is three (3), which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the bylaws of the Corporation.

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#### **ARTICLE V INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRESS**

The name and Florida street address of the initial registered agent of this Corporation shall be: **Lidia Santelices** of 6575 Northeast 96<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Okeechobee, Florida 34972. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the registered office to any other address. The principal address is the same as the registered office.

#### **ARTICLE VI MEMBERS**

The corporation shall have members. Members shall be admitted by a majority vote of the directors upon their demonstration of a commitment to the Christian ministry of children and young adults. Further, qualifications and specifics as to membership notifications shall be regulated by the by-laws of the corporation provided they are not inconsistent with these articles.

#### **ARTICLE VII INDEMNIFICATION**

Each director and every officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding or any settlement of any proceeding to which he may be a party or in which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a director or officer of the Corporation, whether or not he is a director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except when the director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the performance of his duties; provided that in the event of a settlement the indemnification shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interest of the Corporation. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such director or officer may be entitled under Florida law.

**ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION**

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of general jurisdiction, of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

**ARTICLE IX INCORPORATOR**
