The undersigned, being citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation acting as incorporators of a not for profit corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

SUCCESSES UNLIMITED WOMEN & YOUTH BUSINESS CENTER, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business shall be located in the City of St.
Petersburg, Pinellas County.

The mailing address of this corporation shall be 3237 Carlisle Avenue South, St. Petersburg, FL, 33712.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The Corporation's purpose will be used exclusively for charitable, educational, scientific and literary purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. This Corporation is organized to promote social welfare, inuring to further the common good and general welfare of the women, young adults and teenagers within the Greater Tampa Bay area, and the state of Florida as a whole. This Corporation will accomplish its purposes through the following:

1. Providing training and employment programs for individuals, and organizations involved in and devoted to the improvement of human dignity.

- 2. Providing economic and housing development programs and services for individuals and families needing affordable housing opportunities, such as: buy, sale, and rehabilitate housing for women and young adults who are head-of-household.
- 3. Providing technical and professional assistance to individuals and groups needing assistance in improving the health and welfare of low income women and families.
- 4. Providing other services and programs which seek to reduce and/or eliminate prejudices and discrimination which serves as barriers to economic self-sufficiency.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected is set forth in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V POWERS

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes that are not in conflict with the terms of these Articles; provided, however, that notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax pursuant to section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI LIMITATIONS

The corporation shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and literary purposes as a nonprofit corporation. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of

statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend and repeal the Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors, but all alterations, amendments and repeals of the Bylaws must be approved by a majority of the Voting Members.
