ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Of

VIETNAMESE WOMEN ASSOCIATION OF TAMPA BAY, INC.

A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Vietnamese Women Association of Tampa Bay, Inc.

ARTICLE II Principal Office

ARTICLE III Initial Registered Agent and Street Address

ARTICLE IV Incorporators

ARTICLE V Purpose

The purpose of the corporation is to provide educational, cultural, social service, and community social activities to insure cultural preservation and appreciation of diverse ethnic cultures, and to promote community development by fostering a sense of solidarity and friendship among Vietnamese Women and other ethnic groups, American organizations, interest groups, and individuals. The association shall be non-profit, non-sectarian, and non-partisan.

ARTICLE VI Members

The corporation shall have members. Members shall be eighteen (18) years of age or older. Members must subscribe to the purpose of the Vietnamese Women Association and agree to abide by the Article of Incorporation, by the by-laws, and by such rules and regulations as the Association may from time to time adopt. Members will actively participate in the activities of the Association. Prospective members will apply in writing to the Board of Directors, and will be elected by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. Upon attainment of full membership, an individual shall have the right to vote in elections and shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the organization.

ARTICLE VII Board of Directors

This corporation shall initially have four (4) directors. The number of directors may be increased from time to time, in accordance with the by-laws, but shall never be less than four (4). The Board of Directors shall be members of the corporation, and shall be elected according to the by-laws. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as Directors until the first election thereof are as follows:

ARTICLE VIII Officers

ARTICLE IX Limitation of Corporate Powers

In order to promote the purposes of this corporation, it may acquire property by grant, purchase, devise or bequest, and dispose of such property as the corporation shall require for the benefit of the members and not for monetary profit.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

ARTICLE X Dissolution

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE XI By-Laws

The Board of Directors of this corporation may provide such by-laws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes, as they may deem necessary from time to time. Upon proper notice the by-laws may be amended, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of those members of the Board of Directors present at any regular meeting or any special meeting.

ARTICLE XII Amendments

Amendments to the Articles may be proposed by any member of the Board of Directors. In order for an amendment to become effective, the amendment must be approved by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. In the event of a conflict between the Articles of Incorporation and the by-laws, the articles shall prevail.
