**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
EAGLE'S FLIGHT MINISTRIES, Inc.**

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator of a corporation under the Not for Profit Corporation Act of the State of Florida, adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

**ARTICLE I**

The name of the corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation" is EAGLE'S FLIGHT MINISTRIES, Inc. The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

**ARTICLE II**

The Corporation's principal office of operation and mailing address is 528 West Garden Street, Pensacola, Florida 32501. The Corporation's initial registered office and mailing address is 528 West Garden Street, Pensacola, Florida 32501. The name of the initial registered agent at such address is Ann L. White, MD.

**ARTICLE III**

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and religious purposes. To this end, the Corporation shall at all times be operated exclusively for charitable and religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.

All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes in the above paragraph of Article III. The Corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise to its members. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member of the Corporation, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

**ARTICLE IV**

The management of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the Corporation's bylaws. Members of the first Board of Directors shall serve until the

first annual meeting, at which their successors are duly elected and qualified, or removed as provided in the bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the Corporation.


The qualifications for members and the manner of their admissions shall be regulated by the bylaws.

#### ARTICLE V

The names and home addresses of the persons who shall serve as directors until the first annual meeting of members, or until their successors shall have been elected and qualified, are as follows: Ann L. White, MD (9456 Kainui Drive, Pensacola, Florida 32526); Howard A. White (9456 Kainui Drive, Pensacola, Florida 32501); Michael Chapman (7037 Longleaf Creek Drive, Pensacola, Florida 32526); Marilyn Chapman (7037 Longleaf Creek Drive, Pensacola, Florida 32526).

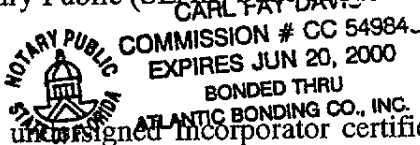

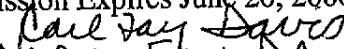
