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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SOUTHWEST FLORIDA IMMIGRANT VOTER'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned hereby makes and subscribes to these Articles of Incorporation intending to form a not-for-profit corporation under the provisions of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation is SOUTHWEST FLORIDA IMMIGRANT VOTER'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively religious and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The objects and purposes of the corporation and the nature of the business to be carried on by it are as follows:

- (a) To educate immigrant population on requirements for obtaining citizenship;
- (b) To educate United States citizen immigrants on the importance of exercising the right to vote;
- (c) To do and engage in all lawful activities that further or are consistent with the preceding objects and purposes of the corporation;
- (d) In furtherance of the preceding objects and purposes, the Corporation shall have and may exercise all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunities now or subsequently conferred upon nonprofit corporations organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

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The corporation may carry out the purposes hereinabove set forth in any state, territory, district, possession, dependency or other political subdivision of the United States of America, or in any foreign country, to the extent that such purposes are not forbidden by the law of such state, territory, district, possession, dependency or political subdivision of the United States of America or by such foreign country.

ARTICLE III EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall have a perpetual existence. The corporate existence will commence upon the filing of these Articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE IV

- (a) Other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, notwithstanding, the Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provision of any United States Internal Revenue law; nor retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, nor make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- (b) The Corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner so as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- (c) The Corporation will not make any investments in a manner that would subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- (d) This Corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (e) In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to no less than two (2) or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue

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Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or to the federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of in the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

- (f) No part of the income of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, or officer of the Corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no member, trustee, director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation.
- (g) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE V INCORPORATOR

The name and street address of the Incorporator is Daniel Morisma, 919 Marblehead Drive, Naples, Florida 34116.

ARTICLE VI MANAGEMENT

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the Officers pursuant to the direction of the Board of Directors.

(a) <u>Board of Directors</u>. The powers of this Corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The number of Directors of this Corporation shall initially consist of three (3), provided, however, that such number may be changed in accordance with the By-laws, and the number of Directors shall never be less than three (3).

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ARTICLE IX AMENDMENT

Articles of Amendment. Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed and adopted by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Board of Directors at any properly constituted meeting of the Directors or by written consent of the total Board of Directors.

ARTICLE X INDEMNIFICATION

Every director and every officer of the corporation shall be indemnified by the corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding or any settlement of any proceeding to which he may be a party or in which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a director or officer of the corporation, whether or not he is a director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except when the director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or maifeasance in the performance of his duties, provided that in the event of a settlement the indemnification shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being for the best interests of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such director or officer may be entitled.


