ARTICLE I: NAME

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (b) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, and Director or Officer of the corporation or any member of the corporation or any other private individual (except for reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes). No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

- (f) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the founder shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, education, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the founder shall determine.
