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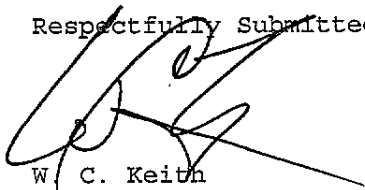

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a corporation exclusively for charitable purposes, under the provisions of chapter 617 of the Florida statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of this corporation shall be STEP BY STEP RECOVERY CENTER, INC. and its place of business is 1330 E. Gary Rd., Lakeland, Florida 33801.

ARTICLE II
PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

NON-PROFIT
