ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LIGHTWEAVERS INTERNATIONAL, INC.

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statues, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation:

ARTICLE I, NAME: The name of this corporation shall be: Lightweavers International, Inc.

ARTICLE II, PRINCIPAL OFFICE: The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

545 East Van Buren Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32301.

ARTICLE III, PURPOSES: The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is to establish an interfaith ministry dedicated to anchoring the Source Light on this earth through religious, educational, and charitable activities and services to the general public, to include: (1) regular weekly spiritual services under the guidance of the Loved Ones in Light, (2) community service, (3) lightweaving workshops and other teaching activities, (4) spiritual healing and counseling, and (5) other activities consistent with these Articles of Incorporation and Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as may be approved, from time to time, by the directors.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV, MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS: The number of initial directors of this corporation shall be seven (7). Their names and addresses are as follows:

Directors shall serve for a period of two (2) years. During the last regularly scheduled meeting of the initial board's term, candidates for director positions shall be nominated and appointed by majority vote of the board of directors based on their ability to contribute specific expertise in areas relevant to the corporation's ongoing activities (including, but not limited to, web site design and development, ministerial oversight, or other expertise as may be useful in furtherance of the corporation's religious, educational, and charitable work and goals).

ARTICLE V, INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRESS: The name and Florida street address of the initial registered agent is:

Having been named as registered agent and to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I hereby accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity. I further agree to comply with the provisions of all statutes relating to the proper and complete performance of my duties, and I am familiar with and accept the obligations of my position as registered agent.

ARTICLE VII: The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE VIII: The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications, and obligations of members of this corporation are as follows: This corporation shall have no members except as provided in the bylaws or approved by the directors.

ARTICLE IX: Any additional provisions for the operation of the corporation are as follows:

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after

payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

In any taxable year in which this corporation is a private foundation as described in Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, the corporation 1) shall distribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code; 2) shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code; 3) shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code; 4) shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code; and 5) shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code.
