FIRST: Amendment(s) adopted:


Article Two Amendment:

This corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families towards a life of self sufficiency by establishing structured support services (for schools), constructing and renovating housing and providing opportunities for land acquisition and affordable, low-cost housing for low and moderate middle income families, and developing strategies of intervention to impact the social service needs of families, youths, emigrants, persons with disabilities and the elderly. The programs will consist of but shall not be limited to: Literacy, Educational Seminars/Workshops, Cultural Events, Job Training and Job Placement, Educational Development, Economic Empowerment, Home Ownership and Home Ownership Counseling Programs, Social Reconstruction and Community Enrichment, Career Development, Teenage Pregnancy and Prevention, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, Tutoring, Youth Activities and Youth-At-Risk Programs, Family and Youth Counseling and other programs to aid those in need.
