ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as the sole incorporator of a Non-Profit Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation is: Bay Village Center for Education, Inc

ARTICLE II Principal place of business and mailing address

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is:

c/o Study Buddy 1405 Martin Luther King (9th) Street, North Saint Petersburg, Florida 33704

ARTICLE III Purposes

This corporation is formed, and will be operated, as a 501(c)(3) organization, pursuant to the terms of the United States Internal Revenue Code.

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To educate children and adults; to operate a school; to seek a charter from the School Board of the Pinellas School District to operate a public school under a charter granted in accordance with Florida law; to operate a charter public school in accordance with such charter; to provide educational services to persons of all ages, both directly and through other 501(c)(3) organizations; and to exercise such lawful powers as may be necessary or appropriate to accomplish the above enumerated purposes; provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any activities that are prohibited to a 501(c)(3) organization.



ARTICLE IV Manner of election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

The initial appointment of directors shall be made by the Incorporator. Thereafter, election of directors shall be as stated in the Bylaws

ARTICLE V Limitation of corporate powers

The corporation shall not engage in any activities that are prohibited to a 501(c)(3) organization. In the event of the dissolution of this corporation, the net remaining assets, if any will be distributed to one or more organizations that qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or as it may hereafter be amended.

The initial bylaws of this corporation shall be adopted by the Incorporator and ratified by the Directors at their first meeting. Thereafter, except as otherwise expressly provided therein, the bylaws may be amended, altered or rescinded only by a two-thirds vote of the Directors voting at a regular meeting or at a special meeting called for that purpose, provided that notice, and a copy, of any proposed change is given at least two weeks prior to such meeting.

The members of this corporation shall consist solely of the members of the Board of Directors. The authorized number, qualifications, rights and duties of the members of the corporation, and of the Board of Directors, shall be as set forth in the <u>bylaws</u>.
