

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF





The undersigned incorporator, in order to form a not for profit corporation, in compliance with Florida Statutes, Chapter 617, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I Name

The Name of this Corporation shall be

C.O.P.E.S., Inc. at Lifeline.

ARTICLE II Principal Office

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 6550 Griffin

Road, Suite 104, Davie, Florida 33314.

ARTICLE III Purpose

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:
