ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I – Name.

The name of the corporation shall be:

Bunch Street Community Development Corporation

ARTICLE II – Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address:

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III – Purpose

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are for:

THE CORPORATION HAS THE PURPOSE OF BEING A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES:

1. To establish rehabilitation center or centers.
2. To assist all governmental agencies in pursuance of their endeavors as they concern rehabilitation of citizens.
3. To establish necessary relations with other organizations or functions to bring about benefit to this corporation.
4. To accept all persons, regardless of age or religion who are in need of the facilities and guidance offered by this corporation.
5. To provide investigative facilities for the evaluation of capacities and classification of applicants in the event such function is needed within the organization.
6. To provide vocational rehabilitation of all persons under the care and guidance of said corporation.
7. To develop the productivity of each applicant and demonstrate his employability to prospective employers.

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8. To facilitate or provide means for surgery, therapeutic treatment, hospitalization, medical examinations and spiritual guidance and devices for trainees and applicants.
9. To provide supervision for training and/or occupational and vocational rehabilitation to permit a trainee to enter upon and follow an occupation and/or have gainful employment.
10. To organize, operate and maintain a youth center, containing facilities for entertainment, instruction and social opportunities for children who, because of financial, physical or social limitations of their parents or guardians, would otherwise be unable to enjoy such opportunities in the general areas in which they live.
11. To receive gifts and grants of money and property of every kind and to administer the same for charitable, educational, civic and philanthropic uses and to do everything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of these purposes.
12. To engage in the acquiring by purchase, exchange, construction or other means, and thereafter in owning, maintaining and carrying on an institution, boarding home or other establishment suitable for the reception, care, treatment, rehabilitation and guidance of all persons young or elderly.
13. To purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer, or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with, goods, wares, merchandise, and real and personal property of every class and description.
14. To engage in any commercial, industrial and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Florida.
15. To generally engage in, do and perform any enterprise, act or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform.

It desires to create units anywhere in the world but specifically with start in the State of Florida.

Finally, it shall have all the authority permitted for not-for-profit organizations to engage in any or all lawful activities permitted under the laws of the United States of America, The State of Florida, or any other state, country, territory, or nation.

ARTICLE IV – Directors

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The Board shall have the power to admit members of the corporation in such manner, subject to such qualifications, and upon such terms and with such rights as may be provided from time to time by the by-law's of the corporation. The initial Board of Directors to hold office until the first annual meeting of the membership and until their successors shall have

been elected and qualified shall be the Incorporators listed in Article VII of this document.

ARTICLE V – Limitation of corporate powers.

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE VIII – Dissolution.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation to another organization or organizations which are organized and operated for the same purposes for which this corporation is organized, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, literacy, or scientific purpose as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organization under section 5013c of Internal Revenue code of 1954 as amended, as the Board of Directors shall determine any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX – Liabilities

The members of this corporation shall have no rights, title, or interest whatsoever in its income, property, or assets, nor shall any portion of such income, property, or assets be distributed to any member on the dissolution or winding up of this corporation. Members of this corporation shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities or obligations of the corporation and shall not be subject to any assessments.

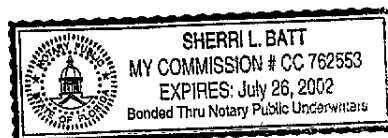


