ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
NATIONAL INDOOR ENVIRONMENTAL
PROFESSIONALS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be NATIONAL INDOOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROFESSIONALS, INC.

The principal address of the corporation at the time of incorporation is 4911 Creekside Drive, Suite C, Clearwater Florida.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The duration of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

Corporate existence shall commence upon filing with the Secretary of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is organized are to promote a forum through which the several disciplines and professions related to the field of Indoor Air Quality may interact to share ideas, skills, experiences to promote a holistic approach toward indoor environmental issues and concerns; to promote the safe and proper analysis and remediation of indoor environmental systems; to collect and disseminate educational literature and data valuable to indoor environment professionals; to facilitate its members' cooperation to their mutual advantage and protection in matters pertaining to the field of indoor environmental quality; to maintain a facility for promoting and carrying out its purposes, through the dissemination of literature and the offering of training programs; and, if necessary to its goals, to purchase, lease and improve such real estate or other property as may be required for such purpose.

ARTICLE IV. QUALIFICATION AND ADMISSION OF MEMBERS

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission by the corporation shall be as regulated by the corporation's bylaws, but shall include as a minimum, criteria for qualification by profession and annual dues to sustain the goals of this organization. Memberships may be held by corporation or associations, partnerships, limited liability companies and limited liability partnerships, upon such terms and conditions as may be set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V. REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The street address of the corporation's initial registered office is 704 West Bay Street, City of Tampa, County of Hillsborough, Florida, and the name of the corporation's initial registered agent at such address is Michael E. Boutzoukas, Esq.

ARTICLE VI. FIRST BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The following three persons shall serve the corporation as initial trustees until the first annual meeting or other meeting called to elect the board of trustees and overseers:

ARTICLE VII. BASIS UNDER WHICH CORPORATION ORGANIZED

This corporation is organized under a nonstock basis.

ARTICLE VIII. INCORPORATOR

The name and address of each incorporator is Michael E. Boutzoukas, Gold & Renick, P.A. 704 West Bay Street, Tampa, Florida 33606.

ARTICLE IX. DISTRIBUTION ON DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) or 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of such code as subsequently amended, or to the federal, state, or local government to be used exclusively for public purposes.

ARTICLE X. RIGHTS OF MEMBERS IN PROPERTY OF ASSOCIATION

No member of the corporation shall ever have any vested right, interest, or privilege of, in, or to the assets, functions, affairs, or franchises of the corporation, or any right, interest, or privilege which may be transferable or inheritable, or which shall continue if the member's membership ceases, or while the member is in not in good standing; provided, that before his or her membership shall cease against the member's consent, the member shall be given an opportunity to be heard, as shall be regulated by the corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE XI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS FULL DISCRETIONARY POWER OF ADMITTING OR EXPELLING MEMBERS

The board of directors shall have full discretionary power of admitting members to, and expelling members from, the corporation, and the decision of the board in such matters shall be final.


ARTICLE XII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS POWER TO FIX
DUES AND ASSESS FINES

The board of directors shall have full power to fix regular or special dues and to assess fines in such sums as may be fixed, or the limits or occasions determined, by the board of directors. The amount of dues so fixed shall become, on and after 30 days' written notice to members, an indebtedness to the corporation collectible by due course of law. The failure to pay any dues or fines assessed shall render a member of the corporation liable to expulsion.

ARTICLE XIII. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION


These articles of incorporation may be amended by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present and eligible to vote at a meeting of the members called for such purpose.
