

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MARBELLA OF ANNA MARIA ISLAND CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

(a nonprofit corporation)

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the provisions of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act (Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes), do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation is Marbella of Anna Maria Island Condominium Association, Inc. (hereinafter the "association").

ARTICLE II DURATION

This association shall have perpetual existence, unless dissolved according to law. The corporate existence shall begin with the date and time of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Florida Department of State.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES AND POWERS

This association is organized for the general purpose of establishing a condominium association under Chapter 718 of the Florida Statutes (the "Condominium Act"). The association shall be responsible for the operation of the condominium located in **Bradenton Beach**, **Manatee County**, **Florida**, and known as **Marbella Condominium** (the "condominium"), to be created under the declaration of condominium therefor (the "declaration"). The association shall perform the acts and duties incident to the operation of the condominium in accordance with the provisions of the Condominium Act, the declaration, these articles of incorporation, and the bylaws of the association.

The association shall have all of the powers and duties set forth in the Condominium Act and, except as expressly limited or restricted in the Condominium Act, those set forth in the declaration, these articles of incorporation, and the bylaws of the association. The association shall also have all of the rights, privileges and powers now or hereafter available to corporations not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, which are not in conflict with the Condominium Act or the terms of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV NONPROFIT STATUS

This association is organized and incorporated as a corporation not for profit under the provisions of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act and it shall not exist or be operated for the purpose of pecuniary profit.

The association shall not pay any dividends. No part of the net income or profit of the association

shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any member, director, or officer of the association; provided, however, the association may pay compensation in a reasonable amount to its members, directors, and officers for services rendered to the association, may reimburse its members, directors, and officers for reasonable expenses incurred for or on the behalf of the association, may confer benefits upon its members in conformity with its purposes, may make rebates of excess membership dues, fees or assessments, and, upon dissolution or final liquidation, may make distributions to its members as permitted by the Florida Not Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP AND VOTING RIGHTS

Each condominium unit within the condominium shall have appurtenant thereto one membership in the association, which membership shall be held collectively by the record owner or owners of the legal title to such unit; such owner or owners shall become members of the association on the acquisition, of record, of fee title to the unit after approval of the acquisition in the manner provided in the declaration. In the event of termination of the condominium, the members of the association shall be the persons or entities who were the record owners of units in the condominium at the time of the termination, or their successors and assigns. This association is organized upon a non-certificate basis and it shall not issue certificates of membership. The association shall have one class of membership.

Each condominium unit shall be entitled to one, and only one, full vote on all matters upon which the members shall be entitled to vote, which vote shall be exercised or cast by the owners of such unit in the manner provided in the bylaws of the association. The vote of a unit is not divisible.

A person's or entity's membership in the association shall automatically terminate when such person or entity ceases to be a record owner of a condominium unit within the condominium. In no event shall any membership be severed from the unit to which it is appurtenant.

ARTICLE VI PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the association's initial principal office is: 1900 Gulf Drive North, Bradenton Beach, Florida 34271. The association's initial mailing address is: 1900 Gulf Drive North, Bradenton Beach, Florida 34271.

ARTICLE VII <u>INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT</u>

The street address of the association's initial registered office is 130 East Central Avenue, Lake Wales, Florida 33853, and the name of its initial registered agent at that office is Jacob C. Dykxhoorn.

ARTICLE VIII MANAGEMENT OF THE ASSOCIATION'S AFFAIRS

All corporate powers shall be exercised by, or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the association shall be managed under the direction of, the board of directors of the association.

ARTICLE IX OFFICERS

The officers of the association shall consist of a president, a vice president, a treasurer, a secretary, and such other officers as may be authorized by the bylaws. The officers shall be elected as set forth in the bylaws, and each officer shall serve until his or her successor is elected and qualified, or until his earlier resignation, removal from office, or death. The officers shall have the duties, responsibilities, and powers as provided in the bylaws and the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE X <u>INITIAL OFFICERS</u>

The names of the persons who shall serve as the initial officers of the association, until the first election of officers, are as follows:

ARTICLE XI BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the association shall be three. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the bylaws, but shall never be less than three.

The first election of directors shall not be held until unit owners other than Gulf Front Beach, L.C., a Florida limited liability company (the "Developer") shall be entitled to elect at least one director pursuant to the provisions of the Condominium Act. Any vacancies on the board occurring before the first election shall be filled by the Developer. Subsequent to the first election of directors, the directors entitled to be elected by unit owners other than the Developer shall be elected at the annual meeting of members and shall hold office in the manner and for the term as provided in the bylaws. Until the Developer transfers control of the association to the non-Developer unit owners, the Developer shall be entitled to appoint and remove all directors except those elected by the non-Developer unit owners.

ARTICLE XIII BYLAWS

The initial bylaws for the association shall be made and adopted by the board of directors of the association and may thereafter be amended, altered, or rescinded only in accordance with the provisions of the bylaws and the Florida Statutes, as they may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE XIV AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

The association reserves the right to amend these Articles of Incorporation, from time to time, in any and as many respects as may be desired, in accordance with the manners and procedures set forth in the declaration and the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, or any successor thereto.
