ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

BayFront Sertoma, Inc.

The undersigned natural person is of the age of eighteen years or more for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Nonprofit (Not-for Profit) Corporation Law of the State of Florida adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:
