ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Stanites SEE, FLORIDA adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is:

South Brevard Area Inter-Faith Sponsoring Committee, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes and is not organized for any purpose other than that permitted by law and its articles.
- B. The specific purposes of this corporation are:
 - 1. To raise the quality of life (economic, educational, and social) of the residents of South Brevard, and to foster community-wide interest and concern for the problems of area residents so that educational and economic opportunities may be expanded, sickness, poverty, crime and environmental degradation may be lessened, and racial tensions, prejudice and discrimination may be eliminated.
 - 2. To train people to create community awareness of urban and rural problems, to provide forums for discussion of common community problems, to research alternatives for solving community problems, and to work as facilitators with community residents and leaders to cause specific and realizable social change.

3. To engage in other activities which will directly or indirectly improve the economic, educational and social conditions of area residents.

ARTICLE IV

The directors are elected or appointed according to the By-laws.

ARTICLE V

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VIII

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing of distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IX

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of its net income or assets shall ever inure to the benefit of any of its directors, officers, or members or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all its debts and liabilities shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
