**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
BAILEY ACADEMY LEARNING CENTER, INC.**

We, being natural citizens of the United States of America and being age twenty (20) and above, in compliance with Florida State law, place the following articles on paper. As residents of Florida, acting as a *Corporation* under the Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act, we do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the *Corporation* shall be *Bailey Academy Learning Center, Inc.* also called The Learning Center.

ARTICLE II

This *Corporation* is a Non-profit Corporation. The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is: 3117 Pershing St. Kissimmee, Fl. 34741.

ARTICLE III

The name of the *Corporation* shall be *Bailey Academy Learning Center, Inc.* also called The Learning Center. Founded in 1999, *Bailey Academy Learning Center Inc. (BALCI)* is, a division of a Christian private school, set up for Preschoolers. It is designed to give low income, at-risk families an alternative to public school they could afford. The principal customer will be the working class family and those on subsidize assistance for childcare. However, we are here to serve all children regardless of ethnic origin, economic or social background. Educational deficits can be found in every part of our society, it is generally the poor or working poor whose children are at risk of not becoming productive members of our Society.

These people also want (contrary to popular ideas) the best for their children and will strive to achieve this. Because of 4C, United Way, Headstart, The Readiness Coalition, BALCI and other resources, their goals for their children may be realized. The common denominator between these customers and resources are their concern for reliability and professionalism coupled with the latest teaching techniques; giving these children the opportunity to excel and achieve goals they will one day set for themselves. This becomes for parents an alternative to their children refusing to go to school and/or dropping out.

We realize that all families can not be helped nor do all families want help, however, we do not and will not lose hope for the ones that can and want help. Placing any child in a BALCI learning environment through the week can help break the cycle.

Once we open as a boarding school our program will be, enhance even more because then we can minister to the whole child instead of just academically.

The school is an environment, where mom and dad are seen and involved, in learning activities with their child regularly. Because of personal addictions and or lack of personal empowerment, the family may feel the child will have a chance to succeed, if taken out of the negative surroundings and placed in a nurturing and learning environment. This engrosses both the school and boarding facility. BALCI, being neutral ground for families, may help each family see themselves and life situations in a different light. Thereby, empowering parents to make changes in their own life styles. Possibly, limiting the need for intervention, from the various agencies, this may possibly eradicate the need for Foster Care or the child becoming a ward of the State. BALCI, will become a place where a dysfunctional family, even for a short time, can be work at becoming a functioning family.

BALCI serves clients regardless of ethnicity or economic status. Prevention, as well as treatment, of acute learning and developmental deficits in education forms the core of our services. BALCI service philosophy is based upon an Eco-structural family treatment approach including family, individual and group verbal therapies, task and skills training and social therapy groups. BALCI and associate clinicians, social workers and family living skills counselors provide task and skill training and refer psychosocial services needed to help families make creative adjustments to living in their communities and to enable them to learn life management skills to function outside of a hotel and shelter system.

Bailey Academy Learning Center Inc. offers innovative techniques designed for effective early childhood education. Administrators and Educators from BALCI are experienced in maintaining a quality model program in pre-kindergarten education and will work closely with professional staff of local resources to provide a nurturing educational environment for students.

Bailey Academy Learning Center, Inc.'s Objectives are to:

- **evaluate the nature and extent of cognitive development deficits common among pre-schoolers born into low-income and empowerment families;**
- **enhance each child's capacity to participate in pre-school up to first grade curriculum, through intervention by a team consisting of educators, psychologists, and other clinicians;**
- **support the child through social and clinical services designed to:**
- **foster each parent's interest and involvement in their child's education;**
- **stabilize families to create the orderly, structured environment crucial to the development of a young child during his or her formative years.**
- **Encourage the use of lending libraries and manipulatives**

- **promote BALCI's "Hands on Training Program" which encourages parent and child bonding the classroom; both participating in and learning instructive play together.**

- **to teach children between the ages of 3 and 6 years through structured constructive play, English, Math, Science, various art forms (sight and hands on), Social Studies (base on different cultural differences and ethnicity), and a foreign Language English or Spanish) depending on the child's natural heritage. Spanish was chosen because we have a large Spanish speaking population in our area.**

- **Enhance the childrens self esteem, while encouraging them to be self-motivated and learn how to be self-directed. In concept this teaches children to work independently and to have a positive image about themselves as well as not being afraid of new challenges;**

- **Promote trust and positive re-enforcement at an early age. Therefore these children will be less likely to make negative choices or succumb to peer pressure; the positive**

attributes will be a part of them thereby enabling them to make positive judgement calls based on their own needs and self reflections;

- continue BALCI's positive personal growth standards which will be evaluated and monitored closely, to ensure our clients and students reach the goals set for themselves within a reasonable time frame without any stress factors.**
- create and maintain a safe family learning environment that will provide an atmosphere of caring, conducive to the teaching staff, parents and young students. This professional educational support team will be the key ingredient to our success.**
- promote a genuine sense of security for parents, that they can be assured their children are receiving the best care possible**

This Corporation will continue to exist in perpetuity until legal dissolution. Its legal existence is not dependent on the continued participation of individual members or Directors. Bailey Academy Learning Center, Inc. shall be governed by a uniform, though flexible, set of rules under state law, those involved in this corporation and those we do business with shall know how they should operate and what will be expected of them. The Corporation shall have the right to amend its articles and by-laws as it grows and the needs of the corporation changes, to make sure it stays in line with current laws and expectations of this corporation. The articles and bylaws can only be changed or amended by the vote, of the Permanent Board Directors (PBM). If PBM can't attend he/she may vote by proxy, signed with a notarized witness signature.

ARTICLE IV

The initial Board of Directors shall have 4 Member(s) whose name(s) and address(es)is/are as follows:

Within the Board of Directors there shall be a distinction between Permanent Board Members and Board members. All Permanent Board members are bloodline family members of founder and owner Carolyn Bailey and are functioning board members. Carolyn Bailey appoints the Permanent Board Members, if she is deceased then the Senior Family Member.

(Senior does not mean age but time spent on board of directors as a Permanent board member) Whereas Senior Permanent Board Member can appoint Permanent Board Members he /she does not necessarily have controlling vote or shares in corporation. Decisions will be voted upon by all directors of the board but the Permanent Board Members do have power the power to make final decision on all issues, privately if requested by one Permanent Board Member. The final decision will be brought back to the other directors, prior to action unless emergency then other directors will be notified by mail as soon as possible. All decisions must be voted upon and won by a 2/3 majority whether in private session or open forum.

This is and was created as a family business and shall remain so. The Permanent Board, which is the governing body of this corporation, shall always be family members. Legally Adopted Children or Children that have been raised under legal guardianship of the blood family members of Carolyn Bailey are and will always be considered blood relatives.

Additional Board members are to be voted in by a 2/3 majority of the Permanent Board members. Selection process is addressed in the bylaws.

The number of Directors maybe raised or lowered by amendment of the by-laws of the Corporation but shall in no case be less than one. It is hereby known that the Officers and Directors, of the Corporation, are conducting business on the behalf of Bailey Academy Learning Center, Inc. (BALCI) (also known as "The Learning Center").

Article IV continued

BALCI shall make a reasonable effort to secure sufficient funds for the *Corporation* to meet its obligations. With the help of a professional accountant and necessary staff, BALCI will make sure that the *Corporation's* funds are kept separate from the funds of individuals, Board of Directors, Board members and *Corporation* Officers. The Board will hold regular meeting to review and conduct corporate business.
